Pastors Pre-Gathering...

Setting the Spiritual Tone

- Local and distant clergy and senior ministry leaders were together in the Rayburn Office Building for an annual gathering preceding the CRNDP.

Purpose...

- A renewed bonding and covenant activation among long time friends and new acquaintance.
- Sweet Spirit of the Lord was present at this appointed time of consecration, harmony and unity.
- Holy Spirit descended and one after the other, leaders released words of exhortation as perceived by the Holy Spirit. It was electrifying. Terry MacAlmon flowed with the Holy Spirit in deep anointing evident to all.
- We left the pre-gathering anticipating the release of God’s power.

Tremendous Anointing at CRNDP...

The wave of His presence and power that flowed over the assembly was in direct proportion to the unity and glory experienced in the pre-gathering.

Intercessors Prayer Gathering...

Prepare the atmosphere, focus on the flow of the Spirit and guard the corporateness of the assembly.

Youth Consecration: Preparing their hearts to receive a spiritual impartation during the ministry flow of the assembly from 4:30 – 8:30pm. Intercessors join themselves to the youth in prayerful heart preparation.

Overview of pre-gathering at the Capitol with the Now Generation

The Intercessors came and they were instructed to:

- Consecrate the grounds.....This is Holy Ground
- Unity in the Body as we gathered
- All would stay in the flow of the Spirit
- Praying that God’s will be done.

The Intercessors prayed in groups, pairs and singles all over the grounds.

When the children came about 4:00PM we gathered together under the leadership of Pastor Patrick. Then Pastor Patrick began by:

1. Thanking God for the presence of the Intercessors to pray for the Now Generation and the youth.
2. The Intercessors prayed for them as a corporate Body.
3. Pastor Patrick asked them what they needed to tell us to pray specifically for them.

They responded:

- Would not yield to temptation

- Closer walk with God
- The Word being their standard for living
- Open communication with their parents and elders, that we would not judge them but disciple them.
- No rejection from the Body, just love them and help them when they need us.

The Intercessors went into groups praying for them individually until the Spirit was finished.

Then the Intercessors set in the midst of the congregation.

They helped to form circles of prayer when instructed.

They followed the lead of speakers with prayer focus.

Stayed focused and connected to what was happening on the platform at all times.

Opening Worship was Electrifying...

Acts of Praise Continued the Worship Flow...

Now Generation Segment

Theme: The promise of Malachi 4:5, 6

- Fathers Generational Transference. Living in that day...The Lord said by the Prophet Malachi “I will move in a way that the Spirit of Elijah will be present again”
- CRNDP 2010 - a sovereign spiritual visitation. (See pictures on www.ICHCNDP.org and read sampling of testimonies)
- **Sealed in our spirits...Awareness and necessity of...**
 1. Fathers hearing the cry of this generation
 2. Responding to their cry in humility
 3. Empowering them to reach their generation
- Clear Prayer focus received for sustained on-going prayer for the “Now” generation.
- Assembly invited to begin a prayer list as representatives of the “Now” Generation shared.
 1. Pray this for our generation that we may awaken: how to live a righteous, empowered examples of Christ in all we do. (See specific prayer request list in Overview of pre-gathering with “Now” Generation)
- **Assembly: Instruments of Intercession**
 1. Small groups of 3 or 4’s petitioned the throne of heaven on behalf of their request.
 2. Youth sang their prayer cry in song “Give Us Clean Hands” by Chris Tomlin, led by Benjamin

- **Father’s Response:...Hearing “Now” Generation’s Cry**

1. Called ages 25 and under to front of stage
2. Ages 26-39 to surround them
3. Ages 40 and older to stretch out their hands

Spontaneous prayer – Spirit led as Pastors, Ministry Leaders moved among the “Now” Generation. We witnessed, CRNDP 2010, Malachi 4:5 and 6 in operation. Surely the “Father’s Heart” is turned toward this generation and “Now” Generation toward the Father. A Spiritual visitation was evident to all.

- **Kairos Moment that Followed When...**

1. Father representative’s repented to God on behalf of the father’s failure.
2. Pastor Jeffery Rogers asked the youth to forgive their fathers and took responsibility for their actions.
3. Youth representative responded in expressing forgiveness to the fathers for their failures.
